

# CANNES EN

This is a mini-expansion for Cannes: Stars, Scripts and Screens.

It introduces a new way to make money, using the pirate ship to show “pre-release” versions of movies, as well as a the ability to store tiles until later rounds.

## COLOPHON

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## PIRATE SHIP

The pirate ship can be used to liven up any party by showing a pre-release version of movie.

When the second distinct party is created (a party is any number of connected party zone tiles), the pirate ship is placed there. The pirate ship remains in play, unless someone connects parties, so that only one distinct party remains; in this case, the ship is removed until a second party emerges.

If a player is connected to the party containing the pirate ship, he may show a pre-release version of a movie (in the production phase of his turn) by discarding a script, an actor or a special effects. For this he scores 4 (million euros). Directly after a player has shown a pre-release, the player to his left moves the pirate ship to a different party.

## STORING TILES

As soon as a player has started his network (has at least one wooden stick on the board), he gains an additional option during the tile placement phase. Instead of adding a tile to the board, a player may decide to keep it on his week schedule. A tile uses up two spaces of the week schedule, and each player can store at most one tile at a time. A player can add a stored tile to the board in any tile placement phase. This counts as one tile placement action.
